ACA UK Intergroup – Service Committee: Safety

Overview:

The Safety Committee was set up to integrate the work of the WSO Safety Committee [<https://acawso.org/category/ad-hoc-meeting-and-service-safety-committee/>] and adapt it for use in the UK. Its remit is to develop strategies and potential resources to help ACA UK address safety issues for both face-to-face and online meetings. The Committee reports directly to ACA UK Intergroup on a monthly basis.

Service commitment:

- One Year
- Monthly commitment, Committee meeting – one hour.
- Monthly Intergroup meeting (3rd Saturday) – one hour.

Suggested requirements:

- Previously held a service position at group or intergroup level within ACA/ACOA.
- Be active in ACA (Working the steps with a sponsor or fellow traveller).
- Be proposed and seconded by ACA members (vote pending).
- Ability to deal constructively with sensitive issues.

Role:

1. Supporting best practice for meetings in terms of safety and well-being of members (including Covid security for face-to-face meetings).
2. Integrating the work of WSO Safety Committee into ACA UK.
3. Liaising with other committees within ACA UK and WSO that may have a role to play in supporting meeting safety.
4. Working collaboratively with fellows, meeting representatives and ACA Intergroup.
5. Monitoring and responding promptly to email enquiries to the ACAUKSafety@gmail.com.
6. Developing guidelines on safety issues.
7. Providing a monthly report to UK Intergroup regarding the work of the Committee.
